

# Reforesting Diverse Native Tree Species in Eastern Nicaragua



The project aims to be a Gold Standard project to generate carbon credits




- **Sustainable reforestation** with native trees (native to the region)
- 936 ha of former grazing and livestock land → **Reforestation on 730 ha, no logging.**
- **No monocultures**, but cultivation of many native species (20 species)
- Long-term project, **at least 30 years**, operated by Ritter Sport Nicaragua.
- **Certification** of a Gold Standard project and **generation of high-quality carbon credits**




## The family-owned company ROSSMANN
